What is Lean Thinking?

Lean is a culture of respect and continuous improvement that creates more value for the customer while identifying and eliminating waste. Lean is a process, a culture, and a way of thinking that aligns project/organizational vision while boosting morale and sense of purpose.

Research finds that construction projects utilizing Lean methods see a reduction in project delays and cost overruns.


Best Lean projects outperform typical projects in the following ways:

- ▶ 61% achieve profitability, compared to 30% in typical projects
- ▶ 57% exceed quality expectations, compared to 17% in typical projects
- ▶ 73% of high Lean intensity projects are completed on or ahead of schedule
