

# LCI Chicago Community of Practice Bob Krier Award

## Selection Criteria and Award Process

The LCI Chicago Community of Practice **Bob Krier Award** recognizes an individual, Company or a Project Team that has moved the design and construction industry forward by advancing Lean as an Operating System of principles, approaches and tools (hereafter “Lean”).

### Selection Criteria:

- **Implementation** –
  - Significant achievements in promoting the use of Lean design and construction tools and techniques within his or her organization, and /or the industry
  - The investment of significant time and energy in implementing Lean design and construction principles and procedures in key projects for contractor, design, and/or owner organizations.
- **Innovation** - Undertaking a seminal role in developing and implementing new Lean tools and techniques in support of project design and delivery
- **Impact on Community** –
  - Leadership in supporting the mission, goals and programs of the Lean Construction Institute, and furthering its program of work in education, research, standards, and/or community of practice growth and development in support of Lean.
  - Willingness to freely share lessons learned and help educate the industry. Has demonstrated commitment to educating and persuading owners to utilize Lean on their projects.
  - Willingness to freely share lessons learned and help educate the industry on Lean via presentations at LCI Congress, local community of practice and/or other organizations’ seminars and conferences.

### Nomination Process:

A \$250 nomination fee payable to Lean Construction Institute and mailed to:

will be collected for each Individual or Project Team nomination submitted. 100% of the \$250 fee will support funding the annual scholarship award. Nominations, including the information provided below, are due no later than October 1<sup>st</sup> 5:00 PM, and e-mailed to **Denise Erminger - [DErminger@Leanconstruction.org](mailto:DErminger@Leanconstruction.org)** (Manager, Communities of Practice Relations, Lean Construction Institute)

- Individual/Company Nomination: Include the individual/company's name, title and length of time in position followed by a 500-word essay covering the key points from the Selection Criteria.
- Project Team Nomination: Include project name, overall project title and project volume, including all the team member names and titles, following by a 500-word essay covering the key points from the Selection Criteria.

### Review and Selection Process:

The nominees for each year's award are solicited from your peers through a nomination process that outlines the key points above. The list of nominees is then reviewed by the LCI Core Committee, which in turn nominates one or more finalists to the Board for its consideration and final approval.

Because of the unique nature of the award, except in unusual circumstances, only one finalist per year will be honored with the Chicago CoP Bob Krier Award.

### Award and Presentation Process:

On October 8th, by 5pm Chicago CoP LCI will contact the three (3) selected nominees. These nominees will present to the Chicago CoP Core Group on October 14<sup>th</sup>.

These same nominees will be present at the Bob Krier Event Night (October 27<sup>th</sup>) and one nominee will be presented with the Bob Krier Award and will be presenting an acceptance speech.
